The Cemetery Expansion Committee had reviewed it and only suggested the addition of a clause removing the expansion from review according to Jaeck. A discussion followed regarding the merits of this option.</p> <p>Rice motioned for Bush to present the board’s suggested amendment to the Historic Preservation Commission. Harrell Second, vote 5-1 (Bush abstention)</p>

Landscape and Grounds	Future clean up dates were discussed. Heat may preclude work in the summer.
Improvements & Expansion	Treadwell and Jaeck reviewed recent work. Chiefly, the committee will want to provide a draft of the policy to the board by their June meeting.
