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Mannington Mills, Inc., has confirmed that an associate at its Madison, Georgia, manufacturing facility has tested positive for COVID-19. The associate, who is not a resident of Morgan County, has been self-quarantining since March 26th and all close contacts have been notified and are also self-isolating for 14 days.

The company employs about 270 people in corporate and manufacturing functions in Madison. In accordance with company protocol, the areas where the affected associate worked, as well as restrooms and break rooms, have been deep cleaned and sanitized and are back in service.

Mannington remains open for business and is following all the CDC guidelines on hand washing and social distancing. Furthermore, with the health and safety of all Mannington associates and customers at the forefront, the following guidelines continue to apply:

- Increased frequency of cleaning and sanitation of facilities, with special attention to frequently touched surfaces.
- Suspension of all face-to-face meetings until further notice.
- Limited outside visitors.
- Reduction of the density of people in the offices via work-at-home.
- Implemented workplace physical distancing measures for those that cannot work from home.

Mannington has relaxed its attendance and sick leave policies to ease the burden on its associates during this time. The company's leadership is closely monitoring the situation in Madison as well as all operations in order to assess and respond quickly as events connected to COVID-19 affect Mannington and its associates.
